



**Update: 21.07.09 JP**

Situated at Bel Ombre, in the south-west of Mauritius, Tamassa is a spacious 4-star hotel with a resolutely contemporary setting for a young clientele looking for a difference. All the rooms, housed in a set of villas, face the sea and are arranged in three arcs, two around large swimming pools with a beach and the third one on the seafront. Around the hotel's main swimming pool, the "Show" restaurant, the "B-Bar" and the boutique are grouped together in a village style, where each component is ideally placed. The view extends from the mountains through the lush sugar cane fields, to end up across an azure lagoon towards the horizon.

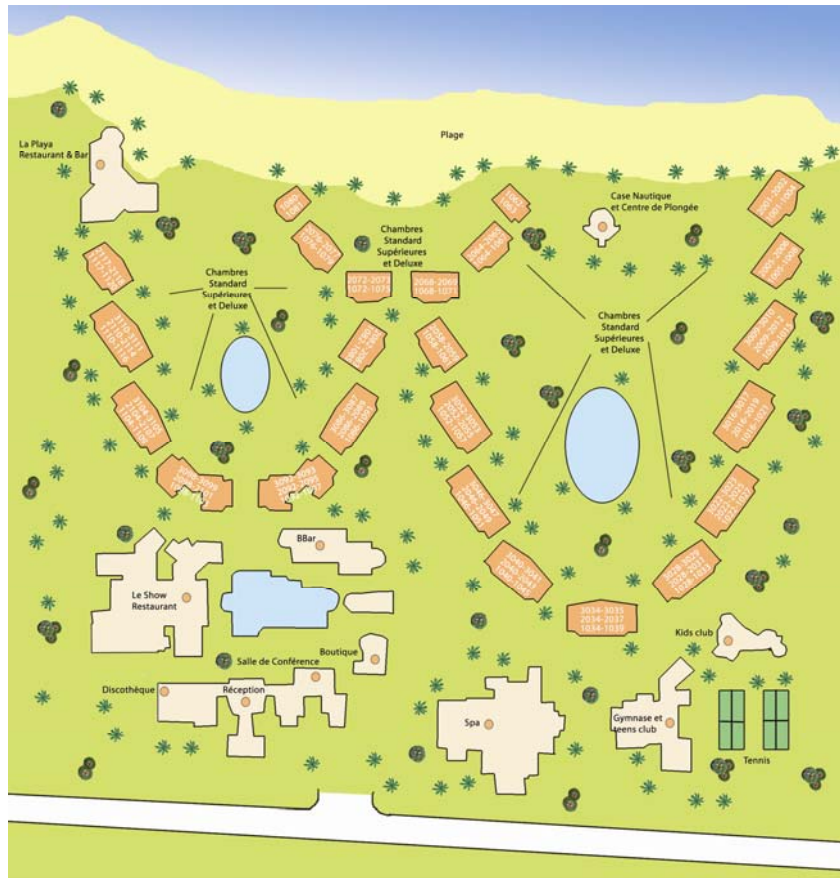

## Accommodation

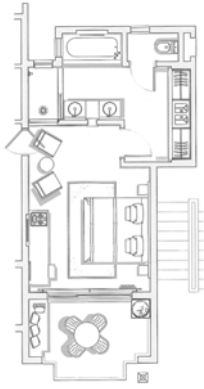


118 Standard Rooms (43 sq metres including the terrace) including 8 Family Rooms (59 sq metres)  
 Standard Rooms have queen-size beds (1.80 metres X 2 metres) or twin beds (1 metre X 2 metres). A sliding wooden door opens up to reveal a spacious bathroom filled with natural light. As well as a bath, there is a separate shower cubicle edged with sintered glass tiling, two hand basins and a separate toilet.



72 Superior Rooms (46 sq metres including the terrace)  
 The bathroom has a bath, two glass hand basins, a separate shower edged with decorated sintered glass tiling and a separate toilet.





### 24 Deluxe Rooms (49 sq metres including the terrace)

Kiatt wood, imported from North Africa, has been utilised for these rooms. In the bathroom, two white porcelain hand basins lay on the taupe-coloured furniture. Adding to the luminosity, the Italian sintered glass Bizzassa tiling lined up in the separate shower is brightened by the light that filters in the bathroom. The bath has marble surrounds and the toilet is separate

## *Restaurants and Bars*

Tamassa's restaurants specialise in two main types of cuisine: Western and Oriental - offering a world tour of different flavours. Particular attention has been given to the restaurant areas.

### **Show - Main Restaurant**

- Seating capacity: 300
- Open from 7.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m., from 12.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m. and from 7.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m.

The restaurant overlooks the main swimming pool. Light beams softly illuminate the restaurant's pure interior contemporary lines, where shades of orange merge into rounded and cubic shapes. The main restaurant is divided into three sections, offering a range of international cuisine, with buffet breakfasts, "à la carte" lunches and buffet dining.

Whether on the terrace or around the small garden, or close to the live cooking admiring the Chefs' dexterity, breakfast, lunch and dinner are served in an always contemporary and lively atmosphere. Thematic dinners are organised at this venue, which also features a light food corner serving refreshments, pizzas, sandwiches and salads. Gala Dinners are organised two or three times a week.



### **Playa - Beach Restaurant and Bar**

- Seating capacity: 65
- Open from 12.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m. and from 7.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m.

This restaurant, featuring South American cuisine, is the ideal place to relax with your feet in the sand, gazing at the sea while enjoying the Latin cuisine or a light salad lunch.



### **B-Bar - Lounge Bar**

- Seating capacity: 150
- Open from 10.00 a.m. to midnight

The main bar is split-level, with a unique décor combining contemporary and traditional touches. White and turquoise predominate in the colour scheme, offset by wood, steel and glass fittings. From the ceiling, luminous globes enhance the subtle atmosphere and reflect in the ivory-coloured flooring, studded with bluish decorative mosaic patterns. The Lounge Bar offers a selection of international beers, wine and spirits. Guests can mingle, intimately installed on the rosewood platform where is set a large circular settee, adorned with patterns reminiscent of the 70s. From there, one can also sit back and enjoy the bar's effervescence and colourful cocktails being served. Two large plasma TV screens, broadcasting the latest video clips, enhance the feeling of modernism.



## *Wellbeing and Leisure*

### **Water Sports**

#### **3 swimming pools**

Free of charge: windsurfing, pedal boats, kayaks, aqua gym, sailing, apnoea diving, glass bottom boat rides and water-skiing.

For a fee: speedboat rides, diving (PADI-certified) and big game fishing.

### **Land-based Activities**

Free of charge: Fitness Centre, beach volley, stretching sessions, table tennis, pétanque and 2 floodlit tennis courts.

For a fee: Mountain bikes, pool billiards and game machines.

There is an 18-hole golf course next to the hotel.

## *"Senses" Spa*

Nestled at the heart of landscape gardens, the Senses Spa, wrapped in soft hues of green, discreetly blends into the surrounding. Indulge in the pleasure of being pampered, while soft music and the aroma of vanilla fill the air.

The spa has 16 treatment rooms:

- 14 double rooms (17 sq metres) facing glass bays and the soft filtering daylight
- 12 metres long pool
- 1 hot tub
- 1 sauna
- 1 hammam
- 2 changing rooms
- 1 hairdressing saloon
- 1 beauty saloon.

## *All Night Long*

A festive innovation: the "Jalsa" night club

## *Kids and Teens*

- Tilapia - open from 9.00 a.m. to 22.00 p.m.

A circular building houses the Kids Club, which is next to the tennis courts. It has a large amphitheatre shaped with:

- 1 dining room on the terrace
- 1 sand pit
- 1 rest room

The Kids Club is for children aged between 3 and 12 years old.

The kids are looked after by qualified staff who organises a whole set of activities, suitable for their respective age categories. A baby sitting service is available on request (for a fee).

Teens Club

- Baz

"Baz", which means place in Mauritian Creole, is a real house for teenagers where the following activities are proposed: games machines, pool billiards and table football. Excursions are also organised.

## *Conference Room*

Tamassa has available an air-conditioned conference room which can accommodate up to 80 people seated theatre-style.
